Dr Moy Gill – Speaker

'The Art of Listening and the Gaze of Love'

Please join us at Salisbury Methodist Church, on Tuesday 3rd October 2017, 7.00 pm for 7.15 pm, for the Listening Place Annual Open Meeting. Our guest speaker will be Dr Moy Gill.

Margaret (Moy) Gill trained as a doctor and specialised in psychosexual medicine. In the 1980's she met Canon Anne Long as she was setting up the Acorn Christian Listening project. They worked together on it for 11 years, with Moy's medical work continuing alongside it. Moy later became a trustee of the Acorn Christian Healing Foundation and still holds that role, as well as being a board member for Listen Well Scotland, a sister organisation.

Towards the end of her medical career, Moy trained in art at Winchester School of Art and UCA Farnham. She exhibits locally in Salisbury. She is married to Mike and they have two daughters, two grandchildren and two cats.
